

Beaming/Warping



The operation of winding warp yarns under equal tension, arranged both parallel to each other and in a certain order.

Beaming can be carried out both in totality (classical beaming) or fractionally (sectional beaming).

The beaming machine is composed of a bobbin creel onto which the bobbins are placed.

The bobbin threads are passed between two rollers to form a sheet, followed by a comb and are finally wound onto a beam (roller holding the warp).
